Marking Scheme for the Hockett Cup *As Revised April 1940.*

Extracts from the rules: "Points will be awarded for each House's exhibit as a whole; for the best set of prints from any one competitor in each House; and for the best individual photographs."

"Work will be judged on choice and originality of subject, pictorial composition and on the technical quality of the prints."

- (1) Each House's exhibit, taken as a whole, will be marked out of a total of 120.
- (2) The best set of prints by one competitor in each House will be marked out of 30. *(i.e. additional to the 120 above)*
- (3) The best photograph from each House will be marked out of 30. *(i.e. additional to the 120 + 30 above).*

The marks will be equally divided between:

- (a) Choice and originality of subject.
- (b) Pictorial composition.
- (c) Technical quality.
