### TRACK AND FIELD ATHLETICS.

At the Public School Sports the School was placed Fourth, only 2½ points behind the winners. In the Athletic Matches there were three wins and three losses (including a narrow defeat by the Oxford University Centipedes' Club). During this year, A. L. SHARPE broke the School record for Javelin Throw, with a throw of 171 feet. B. E. Fox holds the Public Schools Steeplechase Title. The School won five of the twelve Open Events in the Herts A.A.A. Schools Meeting, holds three County Junior Championship Titles, and broke the record for the County Junior Relay Race.
