TRACK AND FIELD ATHLETICS.

At the Public School Sports the School was placed Fourth, only 22 points behind the winners. In the Athletic Matches there were three wins and three losses (including a narrow defeat by the Oxford University Centipeder Club). During this year, A. L. Saasse broke the School record for Javaini Threw, with a three void 111 feet. B. E fox holds the Public Schools Steeplechase Title. The School won five of the twelve Open Servins in the Herst A.A.A. Schools Meeting, holds three County Junior Championship Titles, and broke the record for the County Junior Relay Rec.

SWIMMING. The Royal Life Saving Society's Examiner awarded: Three Awards of Merit, Four Instructors Certificates, Three Bronze Crosses, Twenty-three Bronze Medallions, and Nineteen other Certificates.

THE CHESS CLUB won eleven and lost only one of its twelve matches.
