" F	Collections

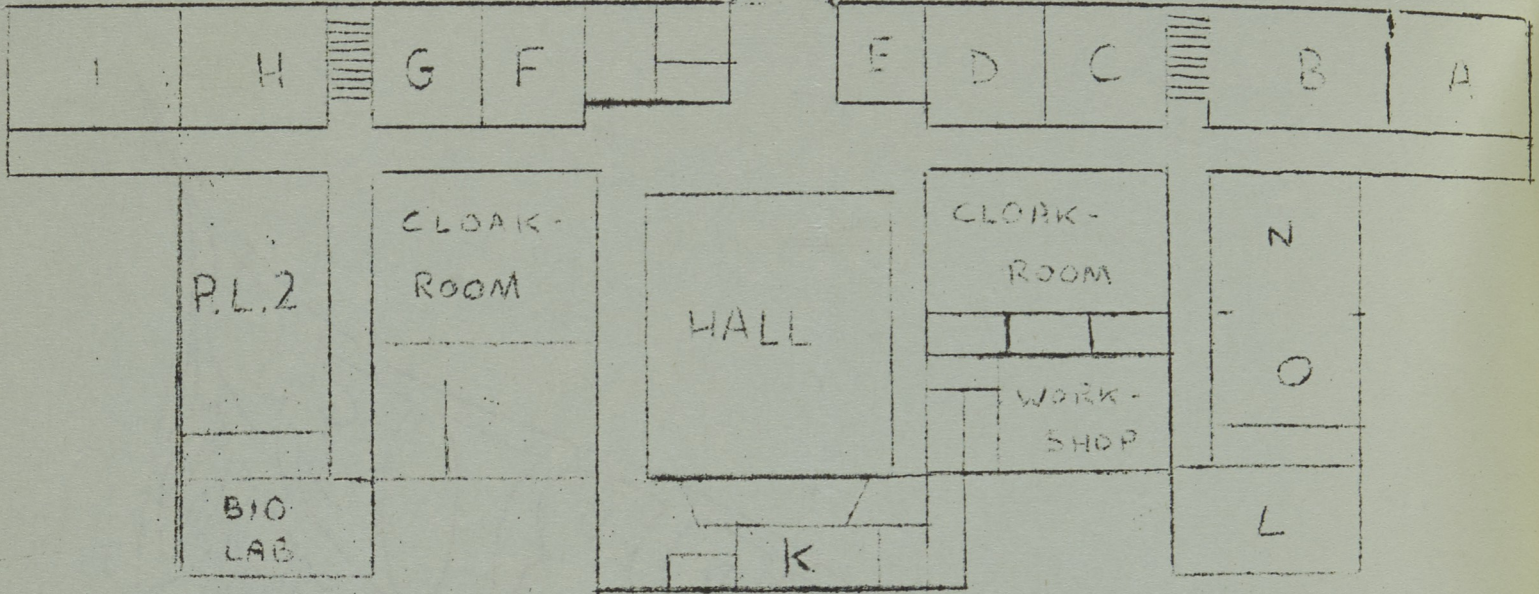
Turn right and proceed along the corridor to:

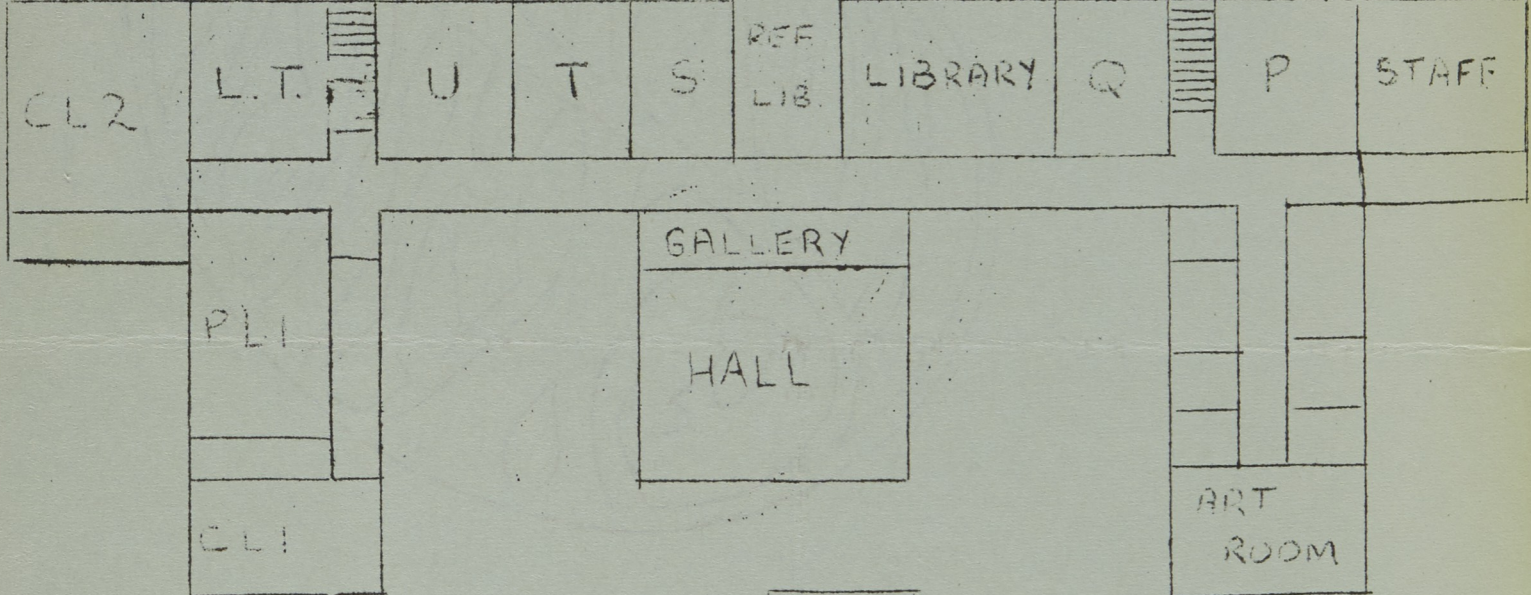

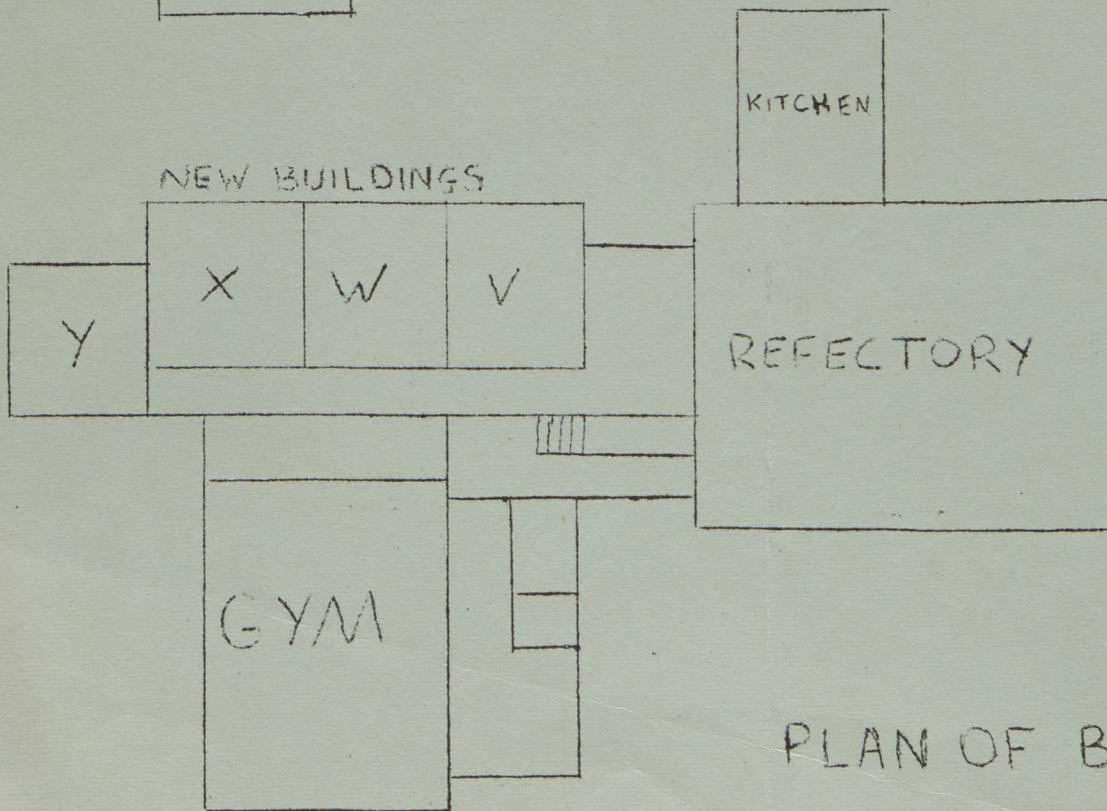
DOWNSTAIRS
